
Sign of Peace

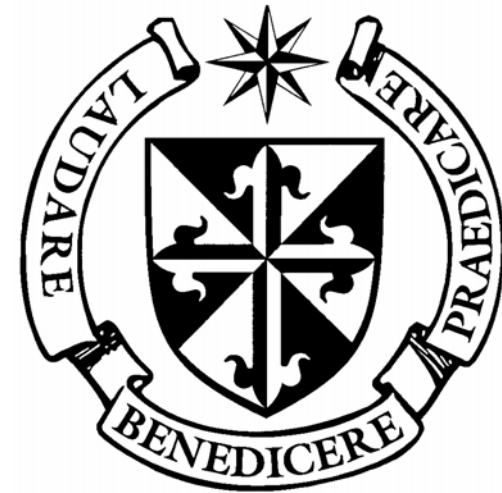
